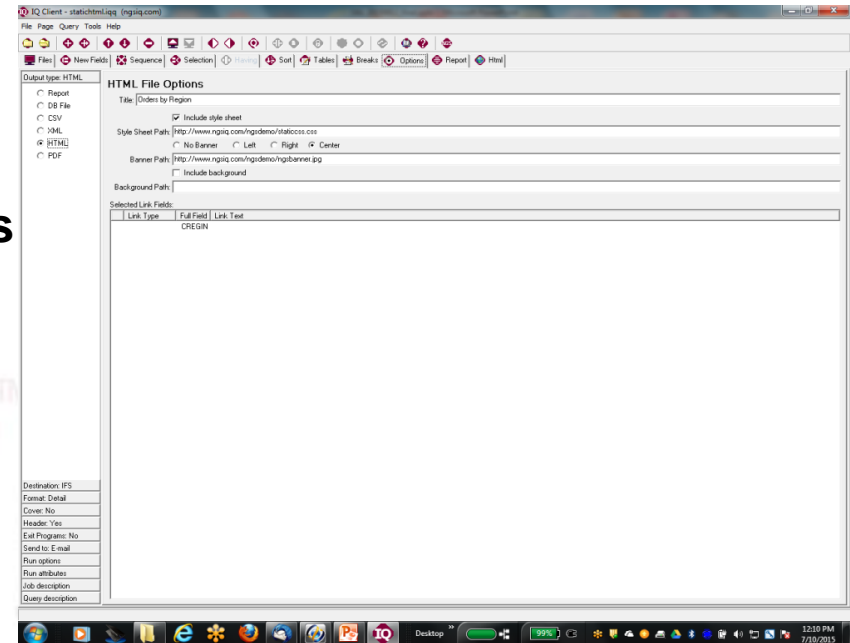


HTML Output to the IFS

- Works much like printer output
- Report is saved and never changes
- HTML formatting options
 - banner
 - background
 - cascading style sheet
- Output can include hyperlinks from report break summary to detail
- Report may be distributed as an email attachment
 - formatting preserved when file is opened within your network
 - HTML report data is easy to import/parse into Excel



Cascading Style Sheets

- A text file containing instructions a Web browser uses to display HTML
- Contains classes which correspond to sections of your report so you can specify things like:
 - fonts
 - type sizes
 - colors
 - backgrounds
 - borders
- Acts as an overlay to the HTML file to create the desired presentation
- Separates formatting from the HTML so you can create a reusable standard and save report development time
- Easy to create using many tools



IQ Server HTML Output to the IFS Style Sheet Classes

Report Section	Style Sheet Class
Entire report when it is the only class defined	.BODY
Entire report heading if it is the only report heading class defined	.IQHPAGE
Individual lines of the report heading	.IQH01, .IQH02, .IQH03
All column headings if it is the only column class defined	.IQHCOLUMN
Individual lines of the column headings section	.IQH04, .IQH05, .IQH06, .IQH07, .IQH08, .IQH09
Entire detail if it is the only detail class defined	.IQDETAIL
Individual lines of the detail section	.IQD01, .IQD02, .IQD03, etc.
All report breaks, except end of report break, if it is the only report break class defined	.IQTOTAL
Individual report break lines	.IQT01, .IQT02, .IQT03, to .IQT09
End of report break	.IQEND
Heading area of a report table	.IQTBLHDR
Detail section of a report table	.IQTBLDTL
Last line of the report table	.IQTBLTTL (the line showing the number of class entries)
