

Expanding Your Options with IBM i Query Management



IBM Query Management (QM) may be one of the better-kept secrets on IBM i. It has been part of the operating system for years, but many developers don't seem to know it exists or realize what it can do.

With **Query Management** objects, the IBM i developer can:

- use the full power of SQL without having to purchase the SQL licensed product.
- take advantage of reporting capabilities similar to those of Query for i (Query/400), including some things (like QM Forms) that Query for i doesn't offer.
- run **Query Management** objects with programs and commands to provide parameterized reporting and data presentation.
